

Review 2011 & Prospect 2012

1. Gospel Fellowship:

- a. In 2011, only 1 group is actively meeting. Meeting take place every other week at member's houses. We have an average attendance of 8 adults + 8 kids. Coworkers are Wade Wang and Jerry Hu.
- b. In meetings we use Pastor Kang's Genesis message videos, followed by discussion, sharing and prayer.
- c. The goal is to strengthen Bible knowledge and encourage daily experiencing of God's Word.
- d. 2012 we want to reinstate fellowship-wide meetings at least once every quarter, with guest speakers.

2. Adoring Lord Fellowship (Mu Tsu Fellowship):

- a. The average attendance is 12 people. Advisor is Virginia Lu, chairperson is Thomas Hu, In the meetings, we share our reflection of the sermon preached by Pr. Jiang and our experiences in practicing God's Word.
- b. There were outings and evangelical dinner gatherings in member's houses. We also had a combined meeting with PTS Fellowship in September.
- c. 2012 prospects: Experience renewal of the Holy Spirit. Motivate members to share the Gospel.

3. Eagle Fellowship:

- a. The average attendance is 12 people. Chairperson is Ming Ming , Advisor is Li Zheng Rong.
- b. The program includes worship , personal testimonies regarding listen to God's voice, and practicing to praise God aloud and videos made by Pr. Yuan Zhi Ming.
- c. The fellowship held monthly dinners to invite non-Christian friends and had two outreach outings.
- d. 2012 prospects: Finish reading the book of Ephesians and continue to cultivate a life style of reading the Bible and listening to God. Hope to establish functional groups and cultivate the interaction between the groups.

4. PTS Fellowship:

- a. The fellowship attendance is 20 or more . Advisor C.P. and Chairperson Gary are the co-workers. The program includes Bible study, sharing and prayer. After May, we share our responses to learning and practice of " Inner lives Exercise" teaching series spoken by Pr. Grace Jiang.
- b. Participate in Nursing home services 1-2 times a month. This includes leading worship, delivering a message, and prayer.
- c. Participation: Join with the zone worship team to lead Sunday worship once a month.
- d. Fellowship hosted a Gospel Meeting on Chinese traditional Festival in June. We also held a networking gathering with Mu Tsu Fellowship in September.
- e. Coworkers Daniel and Eve committed to support the newly established Cantonese group, Holy Division in June .
- f. 2012 prospects: Stable growth; Edify more new co-workers, recruit more people willing to serve and build a better relationship with the Lord.

5. Evergreen Fellowship:

- a. The Attendance is 20 people or more. Pastor Huang is the Advisor. The program includes worship, sharing and prayer.
- b. There were newcomers joining the fellowship since the start of "Elderly Sunday Christian Education class".
- c. 2012 prospects: Look forward to train coworkers who will be in charge of spirituality, visitation, and contact . To establish monthly coworker meeting in order to review the ongoing program and plan the next meeting.

6. Holy Division:

- a. This is a newly established Cantonese-speaking group started on 6.3.2011, The average attendance is 25 people. Daniel, Eva, Robert and May are the coworkers.
- b. The meeting mainly includes personal testimony, Bible Study and watch the movies of Christian testimonies. We held three outreach activities: Barbecue Party, Mid-Autumn Festival and the night of Israel.
- c. So far, there were three peoples who accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior, of which one has already been baptized. After the Alpha Course, we expect to have four more brothers and sisters to be baptized.
- a. 2012 prospects: Enhance the understanding of Biblical truth; edify the coworkers so that more brothers and sisters will actively participate in leading worship, hosting meetings and caring for the members.

7. Rainbow Home Fellowship:

- a. Rainbow Home Fellowship has two groups, group leaders are Huo Ling and Shawn Zhang. Chairperson is Wade Zhang , Advisor is Tony Zeng. There are about 22 people attended the meeting. The program includes Bible Study, sharing, book sharing and sharing on different topics
- b. We encourage brothers and sisters to serve, commit to loving Jesus, to be rooted in Bible truth and live a Christ-like lifestyle. We also emphasized biblical teaching and experience in the area of parenting.
- c. The major activities in 2011 were Big Bear Lake camping retreat, monthly outreach hiking activities , showing of evangelical film, and nursing home visitations.
- d. 2012 prospects: Mobilize members to evangelize, increase in attendance, cultivate spiritual growth.

8. Rainbow Light Fellowship

- a. Rainbow Light Fellowship meets every Friday with ordinary adult attendance of around 45. We start with a love feast where all of us enjoys good fellowship, introduce the newcomers and also invite the youth group to dine with us. We then have worship where every one praises the Lord with songs and prayer in three small groups, quiet down ourselves before Him which is followed by a message.
- b. Along with Bible reading schedule set by Church, Group A has Bible studies on selected books. Group A has completed “Mark” earlier this year and is now on “Acts”. Group B and C use “Inner Life Discipline” prepared by Pastor Chiang. Brothers and sisters take turns leading, usually first listening to Pastor Chiang’s teaching in CD, followed by the sharing testimonies. All groups finish with prayer.
- c. A lot of us use “Daily Bread” which comes in the e-mail everyday, we attend church prayer meetings on Wednesday nights, and form DNA small groups. We celebrate birthdays once a month. At Rainbow Light, we share about items for prayer including members’ needs. Many brothers and sisters joined Taiwan and Navajo Missions this summer. Also taught a few Sunday School courses, led worship for services and provided ushers for service regularly. Our fellowship had a picnic in June at Sierra Madre Resort and a retreat on Labor Day weekend at Lake Arrowhead. Presently we have outreach to invite VIP’s and almost all coworkers devote their time and energy to the Alpha Course. Coworkers regularly meet once a month to seek God’s direction and discuss and coordinate our ministry.
- d. For 2012, Rainbow Light Fellowship continues to seek God’s guidance. We pray that His Spirit be with us so that we may experience Him and His abundance. We pray that we may continue our spiritual growth, and we lay our foundation on His Word so that we live our lives accordingly.
